Bugs come in many different shapes and forms, and some are nice but some are not so nice.

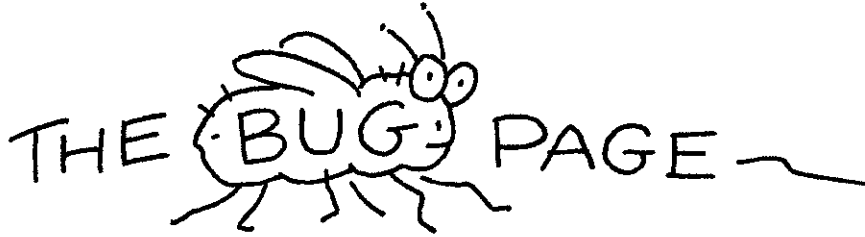

2. BUGS 

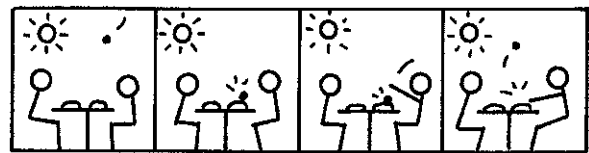
Write a three-word sentence about bugs.
