

**Activity 6:****One Window**

**Today, you will make a window and use it to find some answers.**



Start by dividing the other piece of paper into two pieces by cutting all the way along the line of dashes. Then, cut out the square (and the window inside the square) by following the directions on the other sheet.

**Now, you're ready!** You will be looking for the answers to the rhymes below by moving the window piece around on top of the big square. The things you see through the window will give you your answers.

**For example:** To answer Number 1, you would look for a place on the big square where three T's show up in the window at the same time. That place is marked with a square (to give you the idea). What else has been caught? A small "m," so that is the answer—"m."

Do the rest and write your answers in the blanks below. Also, draw around the square when you find the right places.

1. Catch three T's  
and you get one of these.   m
2. Somewhere in this game  
you can find a boy's name. \_\_\_\_\_
3. Find one big letter that fills up the square.  
What else do you notice when your window is there? \_\_\_\_\_
4. Capture an "A" and capture a "B"  
and you'll also be capturing the letter \_\_\_\_\_
5. My middle letter is really big.  
Can you find me? Yes, I'm a \_\_\_\_\_
6. It may take you some time,

7. Catch four little letters and maybe you might

Cut out this square by cutting along the lines of dashes. Next, fold the square along the fold line. This helps you cut out the window easily.
