A shoe with a thick sole, a child wearing a seat belt, mountains in the distance ... these are just a few of the things students will draw when they participate in Drawing Starts.

But there is a catch: The drawings are already started (just a little bit) so students must use the lines that are there as part of their drawings.

We like this combination—creativity with structure (Your monster with scary hair will be different from my monster with scary hair) . But the starting marks will be the same. It is interesting how much the drawings can differ.

You'll find four drawing starts on every page, so there will be plenty of finished drawings to put on display.
